Policy Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the County's annual dust control program. The program is open for requests from County residents for dust control to be applied on roads in front of their residences.

Application

This policy applies only to residences within the County that are on roads under the control and management of Cardston County.

Private roads, private property, or roads under the management or control of other levels of government will not have dust control applied by the County.

General Guidelines

Each year, the County will place advertisements in local newspapers and on the County's website and social media pages advising residents of the program and the applicable deadlines.

An agreement must be signed by the resident making the dust control application which will include but not be limited to the following provisions:

1. That the County will apply the dust control product when our crews are in the area of the applicant.
2. That the road can be reverted back to gravel when it is deemed necessary by the County which would allow for grading of the road to eliminate potholes, and that doing so does not obligate the County to reapply the dust control on the road.
3. That the County does not guarantee any life expectancy of the dust control product.

Applications are to be made the County's administration building. The cost of dust control application must be paid by the resident at the time the agreement is submitted to the County. The application is to be signed and costs paid in their entirety prior to distribution of the product.

The flat charge per lineal meter will be determined each year prior to the establishment of the dust control program based on the current cost of the desired dust control product.

Dust control will be applied 7m to 9m wide at a minimum distance of 100m per residence. The desired length of road in front of the requested location will be treated with a dust control product only on County roads. The County will have sole discretion over which dust control product is used for this program.

Other Guidelines

Oiled road surface treatments may be available at an increased cost as per the guidelines established in this policy.

Residents are not to apply dust control on County roads using their own or contracted dust control products without prior approval of the Public Works Supervisor.

The County will ensure that the road surface is prepped and in suitable condition prior to applying dust control product.

The County does not guarantee that the dust control product will be effective in eliminating dust but only to control it. Dust control locations will be maintained at the County's sole discretion.
